

The Seventh Annual Convention of the National Creamery Buttermakers Association met at the Auditorium, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, at 2: 30p. m. , January 24, 1899. Acting President W. K. Boardman in the chair. After several pieces of music rendered by the local band, the Rev. Mr. Scott, of Sioux Falls, offered the following invocation: Oh, thou everlasting Creator, give us, we pray thee, a lasting knowledge of thine own creation. We adore thee as greater than creation, as the creator is greater than that which is made. As thy leaping lightning becomes our electric light to illuminate our homes, so, Almighty God, may we remember that the Creator is great and that we live not in a selfmade world, nor in a world made...
