During part of the dry season, from November till February, while the north-east wind blows and tidal action is hardly interfered with by the fresh-water discharge, the spring tide runs from 3 to 4 and the neap tide from 1/2 to 2 miles an hour, while from March to July, when the south-west wind blows, the spring tides run from 4 to 6 miles an hour. During the rains the ebb tide runs very rapidly, from 4 to 6 miles an hour, but the flood tide, as has been noted above, hardly runs at all.
